Job Description

- Assist the Occupational/ Speech and language Therapist to provide suitable therapy interventions for students
- Provide therapy sessions in group format with Therapist.
- Assist Therapist in administrative duties which includes documentation of students' progress using summarised check-lists
- Assist Therapist in work tasks related to school-wide programs which benefit students in their occupational performance.
- Assist Therapist in upkeep and sanitisation of therapy equipment and environment.

Candidate Requirements

- Possess a Diploma (preferably in early childhood education/ special education/ Psychology) from an accredited polytechnic/ institute Or possess at least a NITEC in Community Care and Social Services.
- Candidate must have good interpersonal skills and the ability to work collaboratively with various stakeholders such as Therapists and Teachers.
- Practical experience volunteering or working to support persons with autism spectrum disorder/ intellectual disability is an asset.
